

Northern prawns in brine (900g)











The Northern prawn is a hermaphrodite and starts its life as a male; after 4-5 years it turns female. The species is mostly found in areas with soft, muddy sediment where temperatures range from 1-6°C at a depth between 150 and 600 metres.

The prawns spawn in the autums and the females carry the eggs until April/May when they hatch.
